Please respond promptly to complete your order. • An email notification will be sent when your order is ready for pickup or when it ships. • You may opt-out of the First Day Complete program in Registration Central. By doing so, you will be responsible for purchasing their required course materials through the bookstore. If you fail to opt-out, you will be charged for the First Day Complete program, regardless of whether you make use of the service.


FERPA	Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974
	The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA) is a federal law that protects the privacy of student education records. The law applies to all schools that receive funds under an applicable program of the U.S. Department of Education. Students will need to give electronic authorization before staff are able to discuss account matters with others, parents & sponsors included.

	3% REBATE PLAN-YEAR IN ADVANCE <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Full-time students may choose to pay their estimated out-of-pocket expenses for the full year by August 15 to receive a 3% rebate.
	1% REBATE PLAN*-SEMESTER IN ADVANCE <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Full-time students may choose to pay their estimated out-of-pocket expenses in full for the semester and receive a 1% rebate per semester.
	MONTHLY PAYMENT PLAN <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Arrange to make monthly payments toward estimated out-of-pocket expenses for the semester. Sum of monthly payment plan not to exceed 45% of semester's estimated out-of-pocket expenses. Late payments will incur a late fee of \$25. A 1% carrying charge will be posted for any unpaid balance aged 30 days.
